02 / WHY CUSTOM

A Trophy Built Around the Program

A custom metal trophy can carry the identity, hierarchy and presentation standard of a specific recognition program.

Unlike a stock award selected mainly by size, a custom project can coordinate silhouette, finish, logo placement, engraving area, base and packaging. That gives an event or brand control over how the award appears on stage, in photographs and in the recipient's hands.

Custom Sports Trophies

Build an award language around movement, achievement and the structure of the event.

We can review a custom sports trophy for silhouette, balance, award levels, logo integration and practical production. The metal body may combine cast relief, plated surfaces and painted accents, while the base can carry event information or recipient data.

- Custom shape and proportions
- Event mark or generic sports motif
- Plated, brushed or painted finishes
- Base plaques and engraving zones

Best for: tournaments, races, leagues, clubs and sports ceremonies.

Corporate Recognition Trophies

Corporate awards work best when the form, finish and presentation align with the occasion.

Our design review can translate a company milestone, performance theme or recognition level into a clean metal structure. Brushed surfaces, controlled color accents, wood or mineral-style bases and precise plaque areas help keep the result suitable for a formal business setting.

- Restrained modern silhouettes
- Logo and milestone integration
- Recipient-specific plaques
- Individual presentation packaging

Best for: employee, partner, dealer, sales and anniversary recognition.

DEVELOP A CORPORATE AWARD

Championship Trophies

A championship trophy needs visual authority, stable construction and a clear presentation face.

We can evaluate larger or more ceremonial concepts for casting, component separation, base connection, finish contrast and packaging. A central medallion, relief area or plaque may be developed from authorized event artwork without copying a protected competition trophy.

- High-impact vertical forms
- Coordinated champion and division levels
- Mixed plated and painted surfaces
- Stable multi-part base construction

Best for: championship finals and headline awards.

Competition & Event Trophies

Competition awards can be designed around a theme, category system or event graphic.

Layered metal planes, relief features and controlled color accents can create a strong focal point while leaving clear space for dates, levels and recipient information. We review each concept for practical thickness, connection points, stability and repeat production.

- Original event-specific forms
- Tiered categories and finish codes
- Generic symbols or authorized artwork
- Engraving and plaque planning

Best for: competitions, industry events, brand activations and ceremonies.

DISCUSS THE EVENT

School, Club & Association Trophies

A shared design can support academic, sports, membership and service recognition.

We can adapt authorized crests, program graphics or a simple thematic symbol into a cast-metal feature. Size, finish, base and personalization may be coordinated across categories while preserving one visual family for the institution.

- School or association artwork review
- Shared design across award levels
- Name, title and date plaques
- Protective or presentation packaging

Best for: schools, universities, clubs, associations and community programs.

BUILD AN AWARD FAMILY





Custom Logo-Shaped Trophies

Turn an authorized mark or event symbol into the main structural idea of the award.

We review the artwork for metal thickness, open areas, support points, front-to-back depth and base attachment. Small details may need relief, recesses or painted separation so the mark remains clear after casting and finishing.

- 2D logo to dimensional metal form
- Relief and recessed detail
- Plating and color separation
- Integrated base and plaque

Best for: brand awards, proprietary events and signature programs.

Sculptural & 3D Trophies

Three-dimensional forms add narrative and tactile detail to a recognition object.

Abstract figures, geometric sculpture and theme-led reliefs can be developed with realistic casting thickness and stable support. The design route depends on the shape, detail, mold strategy, finish and how the sculpture connects to its base.

- Abstract or figurative modeling
- Cast relief and polished high points
- Antique or mixed finish direction
- Structural base evaluation

Best for: commemorative, cultural and concept-led awards.

11 / TROPHY CUPS

Custom Trophy Cups

Cup-based awards can retain a familiar ceremonial language without repeating a famous trophy.

We can adjust bowl proportion, handle geometry, stem, base, finish and plaque position to create an original product. The design is reviewed for symmetry, component strength, assembly, surface preparation and protection in transit.

- Modern or traditional cup direction
- Custom handle and stem geometry
- Plated interior and exterior contrast
- Integrated or separate base

Best for: finals, tournaments and formal presentation events.

DEVELOP A CUP CONCEPT

Metal Material Options

Material selection follows the artwork, structure, finish, quantity and presentation requirements.

Copper

Warm metal character and distinctive finishing direction.

Zinc Alloy

Useful for detailed cast forms and repeatable components.

Lead-Tin Alloy

A project-dependent casting option subject to design review.

We review design flexibility, required weight, detail reproduction, surface preparation and structural needs together. No single metal is automatically correct for every trophy.

Forming & Casting Processes

The production route depends on geometry, detail, quantity, finish and the approved specification.

REVIEW CASTING OPTIONS

Surface Finishing Options

Finish changes the perceived depth, contrast and character of the same metal form.

- Polishing for controlled shine and clean edges
- Electroplating for gold, silver, bronze or other approved appearances
- Brushing for directional texture
- Baking paint and spray painting for color accents
- Antique and mixed-finish combinations, depending on project requirements

Finish references, color boundaries and inspection criteria should be confirmed before approval.

Options are reviewed as one system. A change in size, structure or base may affect weight, tooling, assembly, finishing and packaging.

DEFINE THE SPECIFICATION

From Concept to Trophy Design

Start with the clearest information currently available. The design does not need to be complete.

- Logo or artwork files
- Dimensioned drawings or 3D files
- Reference photographs
- Physical samples
- An initial written concept

We review the intended use, proportions, structure, material, finish, base, personalization and packaging. Open questions are identified before artwork, sample or production preparation.

Mold Development & Manufacturing

Tooling translates the approved design into repeatable metal components.

Mold planning considers the parting direction, relief depth, wall thickness, small details, attachment points and later finishing steps. The selected manufacturing method remains subject to the product structure and approved project requirements.

REVIEW MOLD REQUIREMENTS

Polishing, Finishing & Assembly

The visible result depends on preparation and controlled assembly as much as the casting itself.

- Trim and prepare cast components
- Polish or brush selected surfaces
- Apply plating or painted finishes
- Engrave plaques or personalization areas
- Join components and install the base
- Clean and prepare for inspection

The actual sequence changes with the approved structure and finish combination.

EXPLORE ASSEMBLY SUPPORT





Quality Inspection

Inspection is based on the approved specification and the visible details that matter to the project.

- Design and specification review
- Material and component checks
- Casting and surface-finish inspection
- Assembly and base-connection review
- Logo, plaque and engraving review
- Packaging inspection

Inspection helps identify nonconforming details; it is not presented as a claim of zero defects.

REVIEW THE QC APPROACH

Custom Packaging

Packaging should protect the trophy and match the required presentation level.

We can review packaging after the dimensions, weight, protruding details and base structure are defined. Depending on project requirements, options may include individual protection, foam inserts, presentation boxes, private-label elements, assortment labels and outer shipping cartons.

- Protective inserts and sleeves
- Individual presentation boxes
- Branded or neutral packaging
- Bulk shipping cartons

Final materials and specifications are confirmed for each project.

DISCUSS PACKAGING NEEDS





OEM, ODM & Bulk Trophy Supply

Supply programs need clear specifications, controlled artwork and repeat-order references.

We support project development for importers, trophy distributors, event agencies, brands, promotional companies, corporate buyers and procurement teams. Scope may include design evaluation, private-label development, sampling, mold development, batch production, packaging and export delivery coordination.

- Coordinated award families
